Resolution 1, 2012 -Toney Petroleum Inc. Property. Rhonda Oldham, representing the Terre Haute City Board of Public Works, was in to talk to the Board about obtaining the Tax Certificate Lien on 531 N. 3rd Street, Parcel #84-06-21-253-001.000-002 titled to Toney Petroleum, Inc. This property has finally been cleared out of bankruptcy and has been abandoned for several years. The City has already removed the tanks and IDEM and EPA have been on site. The property and aqua fur are highly contaminated. The Board agrees it's in the best interest of the county to allow the city to take ownership of the property and to obtain grants to finish cleaning up the area. The Board approved Resolution 1, 2012, Resolution Offering Assignment of Vigo County Tax Sale Certificate.

Critter Rid will inspect and service as needed the critical areas of the County Court House, County Jail and offices and County Office Building one time per month. The monthly charge for the service is \$318.00.

Expenditures. County Auditor Tim Seprodi presented the Board with expenditures for 1/30/12 – 2/3/12 in the amount of \$719,958.36.
