Acorn Distributors, Inc. Agreement. The Board signed an Agreement with Acorn Distributors, Inc. for soap dispensers for the Community Corrections Building.

HB 1002 & HB 1003. Discussion had regarding sending a letter to Vigo County School Superintendent Danny Tanoos in support of the school corporation to defeat HB 1002 & HB 1003. The Superintendent and teachers of Vigo County do a great job. Commissioner Anderson commented she would like to see the vote of membership that was taken in the State Chamber of Commerce. She thought their job was to support and maintain jobs in the community.

Expenditures. County Auditor Tim Seprodi presented the Board with the expenditures for 2/22/11 – 2/25/11 in the amount of \$691,316.09.

Health Department / Fees. Joni Foulkes and Terri Manning were in office to discuss with the Board about increasing the price of Birth and Death Certificates to \$10.00. They commented there are 51 counties that charge \$10.00 or more for the Birth and Death Certificates. Would also like to increase the fee for corrections to \$10.00, a survey of 55 counties resulted in a range of \$5.00 - \$50.00. Mike Wright informed the Board they would need to amend current ordinance and advertise for public comment. Motion was made by Commissioner Mason to have County Attorney Mike Wright prepare amendment and the Board will review.

Towing Contract. Paul May from Mike's Towing was in office to ask the Board of Commissioners if there was any update on the towing contract that was discussed last year.
