E-911. Chief Jeff Fisher introduced himself to the Board and also stated he was the Chairman of the E-911 Advisory Board. They received approximately 18 resumes for the job of E-911 Director and narrowed it down to two (2) interviews. They recommend to the Board of Commissioners the hire of Robert McMullen. Mr. McMullen is currently the director of Parke County 911 and is well qualified and the Advisory board believes he would be a good asset to Vigo County. Mr. McMullen will come on board May 2nd.

Dispatch. Commissioner Mason commented there are three (3) dispatcher positions open and need to be filled. He questioned who was to hire Sheriff Dept or Board. Chief Fisher commented in the future they will be hired by Director. Commissioner Ciolli stated he would inform Sheriff Ewing to notify Mr. McMullen when he scheduled interviews so he could be involved.

Garnishment Fee. Mike Wright informed the Board that he had been asked by the Auditor's office to look into a fee that can be charged on garnishments by the employer. Commissioner Mason made motion to approve according to State Statute but the motion died for a lack of second.

Dresser Area parcels owned by City. Terry Jones was in office to discuss two (2) properties owned by the City of Terre Haute that are in the Dresser area the City has declared them surplus property and would like to turn over to the County. Terry suggests the county take ownership because these are with the parcels that are in the FEMA buyout program. Mike Wright will send a letter to the Board of Public Works that the county will take those parcels.

County Auditor Tim Seprodi stated he would like to commend his staff Kylissa Miller and Cheryl Loudermilk for their hard work and dedication to get correct property tax bills out on time.

Expenditures. County Auditor Tim Seprodi presented the Board with expenditures from 3/21/11 – 3/25/11 in the amount of \$1,121,456.75.
