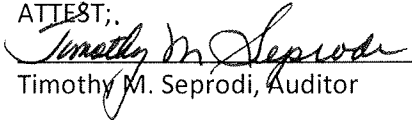

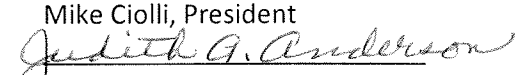
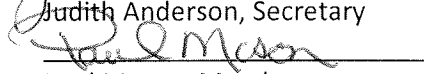

Representatives of both parties have expressed a willingness to actively participate in addressing the legitimate concerns expressed by the residents of the subdivisions surrounding Cobblestone Crossing. In an effort to foster this cooperative attitude, the Commissioners of Vigo County are not going to make any final decision until such time as negotiation is no longer an option.

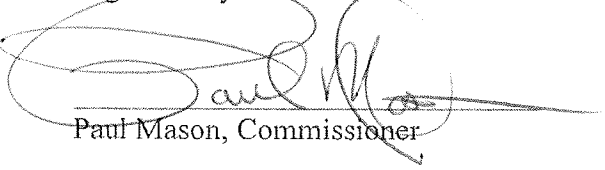
The Commissioners of Vigo County are hopeful that both sides recognize negotiation towards a resolution that deals with the situation as a whole is the most cost-effective solution. It does appear some progress is being made and the Commissioners of Vigo County will continue to stay informed and monitor progress. The Commissions of Vigo County have instructed the Director of Vigo County Building Inspections to issue no new building permits until such time as a resolution has been reached or the situation has otherwise been resolved.
