Lost Creek Township Community Center. Rick Long, Lost Creek Township Trustee, was in office to ask the Board of Commissioners to be the pass thru (Sponsor) for a Rural Community Development Block Grant that he was going to apply for. The Township was given five (5) acres of land behind the current Trustee's office. Public meetings were held to get some ideas of what to do with the land. It was suggested a Community Center be built. It would house the Trustee's office, a computer room for public use, a Multi- Purpose room that would hold approximately 200 – 250 people that could be used for meetings or rented out. And this would allow them to have a small food pantry and library. The plans also include a walking trail behind the facility. Water drainage is already taken care of. The question had been asked if the Trustee's budget would be able to maintain it and Rick said yes there is no problem with that. Mr. Long plans on applying for the full \$400,000.00 grant, but he is to meet with Ron Hinsenkamp and Terry Jones of West Central (Grant Administrator) at 11:00 a.m. to go over the process and all the particulars. There would be no money from the County. There is a Friends for Seelyville Building Fund set up that someone can make donations to and be tax deductible. Rick commented he would take this to the Seelyville Town Board if he needed to, but would rather go thru the county. County Auditor Tim Seprodi asked where the County Authority begins and Town Board ends. It was stated this is a Township project and the Lost Creek Township Board is in favor. The Board of Commissioners commented they look at this project favorably, but would like to know what their responsibilities are after Rick meets with the West Central representatives.

There being no further business, it is now ordered the Board be recessed.
