Comments from Public/Elected Officials.

Kevin Gardener asked the Commissioners since there is an overcrowding issue why not put bracelets on the offenders and have Community Corrections deal with them. The Commissioners explained that those in jail have been given the opportunity for this option but either do not qualify or have already failed the program. The Vigo County Court's make the decisions as to who will go into the program.

Kevin Gardener also asked how the Blight Elimination Program is handled. County Attorney Mike Wright explained that the IHCD administers and scores properties based on certain criteria. A participating third party may go to the homeowner and offer a predetermined amount for sale. If the homeowner consents they will receive \$6000.00 for a home without a basement. They will receive \$10,000 for a home with a basement. Once this is settled, the property is then turned over to the County. Kevin Gardener informed the Commissioners there is a home that would most likely qualify in Dresser. He was instructed to speak with Dale Sowards in Vigo County Building Inspection.
