Chuck Wiley addressed the Board with his concern regarding the storm water fee that will be applied to parcels. He also informed them of other information regarding his property and county road access.

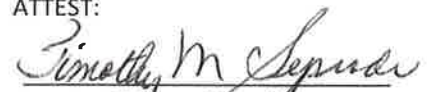
