Petition for Vacation of Right of Way. Dave Dillon, Deputy Auditor, presented to the Board a signed petition by the petitioner Michael H. O'Vivion for the vacation of the Right of Way. A portion of Boring Avenue as platted and laid out in Ehrmann Coal Company's 2nd Addition in section 25, Township 13 North, Range 8 West, Nevins Township, Vigo County, Indiana, as shown in the Office of the Vigo County Recorder, and more particularly described to wit: All that part of said Boring Avenue bounded on the North by Lots 8 through 18 and on the South by Lots 19 through 29 and that portion bordered by an apparent abandoned and unassessed rail road. Lease Extension with Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC. County Attorney Mike Wright presented a lease extension with Time Warner Cable to the Board for the 2290 South 13th Street Terre Haute, IN 47802 property. They are proposing that the lease gets extended from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2023 of the base minimum rate for \$2,000.00 per month and \$24,000.00 annually with proposed two additional 5 year options to renew and then base rent would be negotiated through each renewal commencement and agreed upon by both the parties.

Contract with DLZ. County Attorney Mike Wright presented to the Board a contract with DLZ that is in final form. This proposes the project schedule. This is a contract for design services and they would design anything we need them too. . It indicates that we have engaged a construction manager as advisor that we anticipate there will be multiple prime contractors that will be awarded under the work statue under the construction manager. Resolution 4- Assigning Tax Sale Certificates to the West Vigo Levee Association Conservancy District. County Attorney Mike Wright presented to the Board 6 parcels that are in West Terre Haute. Three of them are adjacent to the West Terre Haute Levee and three that are in the BEP. The three that are in the West Vigo Levee are 84-06-20-354-002.000-022 (Lot 100 ft. Se. of Backyard of 32 Summer), 84-06-20-354-003.000-022 (Lot 225 ft. Se. of Backyard of 32 S. Summer), 84-06-30-180-007.000-021 (1 acre lot starting at levee to W. of intersection of 10th & cherry grove). The West Vigo Levee is wanting to obtain the tax sale certificates for these properties and pay taxes on them. The three that are in the BEP are 84-

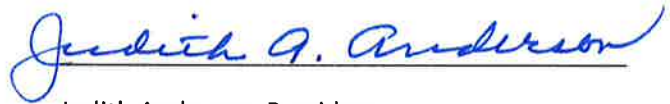

Hall Ave, Terre Haute), 84-06-30-236-005.000-022 & 84-06-30-236-006.000-022 (518 S. 3rd street, West Terre Haute), 84-06-30-259-003.000-022 (1002 S. 7th Street, West Terre Haute). The Board of Commissioners approves the assignments of the tax sale certificates to West Terre Haute Redevelopment and West Vigo Levee and all taxes, penalties, and assessments against the properties shall be waived for the 2016 pay 2017 tax year and prior. The period of redemption of the properties described herein for 120 days from the date the certificates are assigned. **Motion: Action:** Approve, **Moved by:** Brad Anderson, Seconded by: Jon Marvel, **Passed:** all ayes.
