Comments from Public or other Vigo County Representatives. Amy Sons presented to the Board an issue with the Toadhops area. There has always been flood problems. A lot of the issue involves the ditch that runs along Highway 40 through Toadhops and along the ditch which gets full of debris and trash which prevents it from flowing into Sugar Creek. Amy and her husband has spent two days pumping out Toadhops. Sugar Creek scrap donated two pumps and West Terre Haute Water Works brought an Industrial pump and pumped the ditch out. Once the water is low enough the remaining dirt and debris will be able to be cleaned from the ditch and tunnel to allow better flow to Sugar Creek. The residents of Toadhops are willing to purchase this area and maintain it. Everyone in Toadhops has put their money together to buy an Industrial size pump for this ditch. Jerry Netherlain is going to get a hold of INDOT and the County Commissioners will also do what they can to help with this situation.

Greg Goode commented to the Board and appreciates the Commissioners continued interest in the Hulman Center project. Thank You!

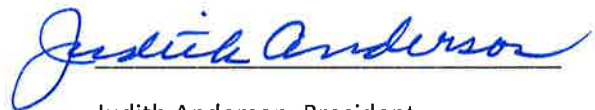

Jerry stated that he has driven the roads with them and he has driven the roads after they did the work on them, but all the roads but the Farmersburg are okay. Neither one of the antique bridges are closed. The one bridge in Farmersburg from 246 up to a quarter of a mile is closed, the one in Briggs Street they closed north of the bridge, passed 246 up to a quarter of a mile from the bridge.

Andres Kummerow and Lisa Spence presented to the Board their concerns with the New Vigo County Jail. Their concerns that they presented are the number of beds, trying to seek help for the inmates to eliminate jail population such as sending them to the Hamilton Center and any other facility that meets their addiction needs.

Mike Gordon commented to the Board about his concerns with the Commissioners Meeting being held in the morning during work hours and it's hard for the public to come to the meetings and get time away from work to participate. Another concern Mike Gordon has is the budget for the new jail and how much is it going to cost to operate this facility.

Gerrie Varner commented to the Board and stated that she hopes we can all come together on the new jail and seek help for those who are wanting help to overcome their problems they are having that continues them to keep going back to jail.
