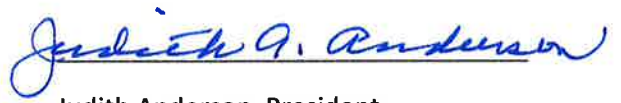
Jeremy Snowden commented to the Board that the bicentennial logo he received the resources this morning and just has a few technical things to take care of.
