President Aaron Loudermilk called the meeting to order at 4:00.

Calling of the roll

Present: R. Todd Thacker - present, Vicki Weger - present, Marie Theisz - present, Travis Norris – present, Brenda Wilson - present, David Thompson – present, Aaron Loudermilk - present.

Correcting of the journal of the preceding meeting if needed

November 1, 2022 Sunshine Meeting

November 9, 2022 Regular Meeting

There were no corrections to the minutes of the November 1, 2022 Sunshine Meeting. Todd Thacker made a motion to approve the minutes of the Sunshine Meeting. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote of 7-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the November 9, 2022 regular meeting. David Thompson made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote of 7-0, the motion was unanimously approved.

Public Comments – limited to items NOT on tonight's agenda

There were none.

Communications from elected officials, other officials or agencies of the County

There were none.

**Resolutions 2022-13 & 2022-14, ROC 2022-38: Saturn Petcare, Inc.
10-year personal and real property tax abatement**

President Loudermilk opened the meeting as a public hearing for the proposed tax abatements for Saturn Petcare, those being Resolution 2022-13 for personal property and Resolution 2022-14 for real property. Attorney Richard Shagley, attorney for Saturn Petcare, first introduced the CEO of the company who had flown in from New Jersey and a board member who had flown in from Germany for this meeting. Mr. Shagley indicated that the two resolutions being considered tonight have been amended as had been previously discussed. To show their commitment to use local labor, they included in the resolutions and SB-1's their intent to use local contractors Freitag-Weinhardt and Sycamore Engineering. They have been using both contractors since the beginning of the year. Those are the only amendments to the documents presented tonight. Travis Norris asked if they were working on a plan with Honey Creek Fire District. Mr. Shagley indicated that he had been working with the Fire Department and with their attorney getting things in order. Todd Thacker asked about when their current abatement was established and there was a brief discussion. There was a lengthy discussion about this request for a 100% 10-year tax abatement versus a prorated 10-year abatement. Mr. Shagley indicated that Saturn Petcare was committed to this community by choosing to conduct their business here, by staying here and by expanding their growth. Discussion continued. Todd Thacker said that in looking at a document showing what the tax savings would be on a sliding scale abatement rather than

100%, the tax savings are still substantial and he would be more inclined to support the abatements with a sliding scale. Mr. Shagley indicated that they would like to proceed with the abatements as originally presented with 100% abatement. They have given an absolute commitment in writing to using local labor, would be adding 50 additional jobs with a substantial income package, and they believe the added value would substantiate the 100% abatement requested. Discussion continued. Aaron Loudermilk noted that the Council had asked for certain concessions from Saturn Petcare, they had followed through with the request and he felt that the Council should keep their end of the bargain. Mr. Thacker said he did not disagree with Councilman Loudermilk and he was definitely not against Saturn Petcare's request but he felt that a standard sliding scale 10-year abatement would be better for the County. Brenda Wilson said that she was a big proponent for this and made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-13 as presented. President Loudermilk said that could not be done until the public hearing was closed. Discussion continued. Jason King, representative for the carpenters in Terre Haute, expressed his appreciation to Saturn Petcare for their local commitment. He did suggest some additional language that he would like to see put in this and future tax abatements regarding usage of local labor. President Loudermilk closed the public hearing at 4:40 p.m. He then moved on to the final reading of abatement for Saturn Petcare, Inc. Resolution 2022-13 10-year Personal Property Tax Abatement. Travis Norris then made a motion to proceed with the 10-year 100% tax abatement for Saturn Petcare Resolution 2022-13 as presented. Brenda Wilson seconded the motion. Council Attorney Robert Effner said as he understands Mr. Norris' motion, it is to approve the final action as presented in the booklet dated December 6, 2022. Mr. Norris confirmed that. He also said he hoped Saturn Petcare continued forward with internships with the local schools and that they continued to use local labor going forward. He also talked about the other benefits this will bring to the community in terms of housing, food and beverage tax, etc. Mr. Shagley added that it will also benefit the employees of Saturn who will no longer have to travel long distances to work and be able to spend quality time with their families. After some further discussion, a roll call vote was taken as follows: Todd Thacker – nay; Vicki Weger – aye; Marie Theisz – aye; Travis Norris – Aye; Brenda Wilson – aye; David Thompson – aye; Aaron Loudermilk – aye. By a 6-1 vote, the motion passed. President Loudermilk then moved to the final reading of Resolution 2022-14 10-year Real Property Tax Abatement. Council Administrator Kylissa Miller said before proceeding further, the Statement of Benefits for Real Estate Improvements had a couple of areas that needed to be fixed, those being the start date and completion date. Mr. Shagley said the start date would be third quarter 2023 and completion date fourth quarter of 2024. Ms. Miller said she will put the estimated start date as July 1, 2023 and estimated completion date December 31, 2024. In Section 4, Current Value should be zero and Current Value in Assessed Value should be zero; estimated value of proposed project should be \$8,000,000 for the cost and the estimated values upon completion should be \$8,000,000 in each column. President Loudermilk said he would entertain a motion to approve Resolution 2022-14 as presented. Mr. Effner said the motion should be to adopt the final action by the Council regarding Resolution 2022-14 Real Property as presented in the booklet of the Council dated December 6, 2022. Vicki Weger made that motion. Brenda Wilson seconded the motion. Upon a roll call vote, voting was as follows: Todd Thacker – nay; Vicki Weger – aye; Marie Theisz – aye; Travis Norris – Aye; Brenda Wilson – aye; David Thompson – aye; Aaron Loudermilk – aye. By a 6-1 vote, the motion passed.

Pledge of Allegiance

Auditor James Bramble called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Calling of the roll

Present: R. Todd Thacker, Travis Norris, Marie Theisz, Vicki Weger, Nancy Allsup, David Thompson, Aaron Loudermilk.

Reorganization

Mr. Bramble stated that the first order of business was to open nominations for President. Vicki Weger made a motion to elect Todd Thacker as President. Marie Theisz seconded the motion. With no other nominations and upon a voice vote of 7-0, the motion was unanimously passed and Todd Thacker was elected President. President Thacker then asked for nominations for President Pro Tem. Nancy Allsup made a motion to elect Marie Theisz as President Pro Tem. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. With no other nominations and upon the motion of Vicki Weger to close nominations, with a voice vote of 7-0, the motion was unanimously passed and Marie Theisz was elected as President Pro Tem.

The next order of business was the adoption of rules. The proposed rules for this year had been distributed to the Council. Council Administrator Kylissa Miller said that the only changes for this year's rules are the dates. Vicki Weger said that inasmuch as the rules were to be the same as last years with the exception of updated dates, she made a motion to accept the rules for 2023. Travis Norris seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 7-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Next was adoption of a tentative meeting schedule for 2023. Proposed schedules for meeting dates for the Sunshine Meetings and Voting Meetings for 2023 and deadlines for filing, publication, first reading and final vote had been provided to each Council member. It was noted that on Tuesday, April 4, and Tuesday, April 11, and Tuesday, October 10, a different location will need to be used due to early voting taking place in the Council Chambers. Kylissa Miller said she had emailed the City Clerk to see if we could use the City Hall Court Room again, if that was the wish of the Council, but she has not yet heard back. She also said that Tuesday, May 2, and Tuesday, November 7, government offices would be closed for Election Day and those meeting dates could be scheduled on Wednesday, May 3, and Wednesday, November 8, as had been done in the past; otherwise the timeline would have to be pushed back a week which would change all the dates for deadlines. After discussion, it was decided to move those particular meetings to the following Wednesday (May 3 and November 8). Marie Theisz made a motion to approve the tentative meeting schedule for 2023 with the changes of Tuesday,

May 2, changed to Wednesday, May 3, and the change in November from Tuesday, November 7, to Wednesday, November 8. Vicki Weger seconded the motion. Upon a voice vote of 7-0, the motion unanimously passed.

Public Comment.

Matt Larimer, 363 West Cutsinger Drive, wanted to call attention to a couple of local issues. First, he believed there was improper use of commissary funds in the last election. In the County Prosecutor's campaign finance report, there was a direct contribution listed from the Sheriff's Commissary Fund. He believed that in reading the Indiana Code, such was not an approved use of those funds. He said the guidelines were pretty strict with the one exception being if the Sheriff gets permission from the County's fiscal body to use those funds other than the State's guidelines. The second issue related to the County Coroner contracting with a local pathologist, Dr. Bamidele Adigbo, who recently pled guilty. In following up on the issue, Mr. Larimer came across an in-depth investigation from KWCH Channel 12 in Wichita, Kansas where they did an in-depth investigation of his education and work history and found several inconsistencies, former employers who said he never worked for them, and some of his credentials were never verified. Mr. Larimer will send an email with the details to the Council members. President Thacker said he would ask the County Attorney look at the emails and advise the Council what, if anything, it could do and any appropriate action that could be taken.

Communications from elected officials of the County
