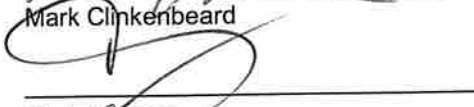
Comments or other business from Commissioners or other Elected Officials.

The meeting was recessed at 9:12 am.

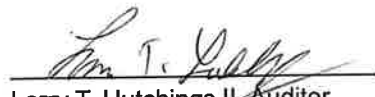
