TIRE AMNESTY TIME IS HERE!



Tires are prime breeding grounds for mosquitoes which carry the West Nile Virus. Proper disposal of tires will reduce the spread of the virus in Vigo and other surrounding counties. Help reduce the risk of West Nile Virus in our community! Did you know that Vigo County has a tire storage ordinance? The purpose of this ordinance is to protect the public health and welfare by declaring improperly stored tires as a public nuisance and a significant health hazard (3-57-1).

Date: April 1st - May 4th, 2026

Time: 8:30 AM - 3:30 PM (Monday - Friday)

Where: Vigo County Health Department Vector Control

What: Bring old tire(s) with or without rims lying around your property, by APPOINTMENT ONLY!

Vigo County Residents Only! Proof of residency required!

Cost: Free to the public (up to 10 tires)

No Businesses, Tire Retailers, Salvage Yards, Auto Service Centers or trucking Companies Allowed.

PLEASE READ PRE-AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENTS BEFORE BRINGING US YOUR TIRES

- Tire drop off by APPOINTMENT ONLY (812) 234 - 9181
- No more than 10 tires without pre-authorization or a fee will occur.
- Semi tires, tractor tires, or larger MUST have pre-authorization.
- NO EXCEPTIONS!!! Without authorization, a charge will occur.
- *The Vigo County Health Department is not responsible for any accidents or damage to vehicles.*
