Mark Clinkenbeard proposed offering funding the City's request for Warming Center Funding using already budgeted funds the Community Development line in the EDIT Fund. There was brief discussion on this request before the Vigo County Council and the difficulty the City of Terre Haute was having getting this request re-approved. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve the \$11,900 needed to cover the invoice for the warming center operations using already budgeted funds in the EDIT Fund, noting the County should make good on previous commitments. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Mark Clinkenbeard noted there would be a ribbon cutting for a new housing development in Seelyville later that day.

Mark also mentioned there would be a dedication for the overlook at Dewey Point the following Saturday.

Auditor Larry Hutchings thanked department heads and elected officials for their efforts in submitting the necessary information for GAAP reporting.

Chris Switzer briefly discussed efforts to inventory and assess the multiple contracts the county has with copier rental vendors.
