Review of minutes/claims.

Auditor Larry Hutchings presented the minutes from the July 14th, 2026 Commissioners' Meeting. Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve the July 14th, 2026 Commissioners' Meeting minutes as presented. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. With a voice vote of 3-0 the motion passed.

The claims docket dated July 10th, 2026 through July 16th, 2026 in the amount of \$5,752,638.84 was presented to the Board. EPIC – County Workers Comp - Commissioners

Mark Clinkenbeard noted in 2024 the premium was \$444,856. In 2025 it was \$485,629 and this year it is \$409,510. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve the EPIC Renewal. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 vocal vote.

Ordinance 2026-10 Demolition – Commissioners

Mark Clinkenbeard mentioned they have been working on cleaning up dilapidated and vacant properties. Terry Modesitt stated this ordinance mirrors the State statute. Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve the Ordinance 2026-10. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 vocal vote.

Resolution 2026-9 Commissioners Accepting Personal Property from TH Board of Public Works

Terre Haute Police Department has a nFuse Exterior Full Size Lightbar they are no longer using. This ordinance authorizes the transfer of property from THPD to the Vigo County Commissioners, on behalf of the Vigo County Sheriff's Office. Mike Morris made a motion to approve the Resolution 2026-9. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 vocal vote.

Nursing Contract – Norm Loudermilk

Norm stated these contracts are Memorandum of Understanding for the nursing services and director of nursing for the group homes. Mark Clinkenbeard mentioned the director of nursing pay rate is \$95.00 per

contract hour, not to exceed 3 hours per week. The nursing services are \$75.00 per contract hour, not to exceed 3 hours per week. Norm mentioned these are as needed services and the director of nursing is also a family practitioner. Chris Switzer made a motion to approve both nursing contracts. Mark Clinkenbeard seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 vocal vote

Barnes and Thornburg – Oversight Board

Mark Clinkenbeard made a motion to approve a payment to Barnes & Thornburg for the Oversight Board in the amount of \$2,269.50. Chris mentioned the board approved the invoice yesterday. Of the \$100,000 that was given to the Oversight Board they have roughly \$87,000 remaining. Chris Switzer seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 vocal vote.

Public Comments. There were none.

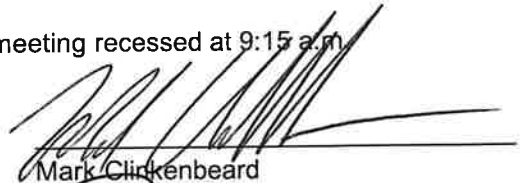
Comments or other business from Commissioners or other Elected Officials.
