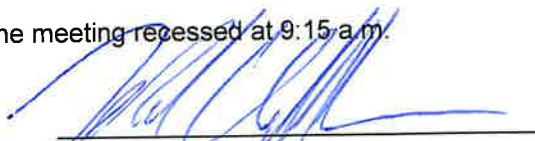
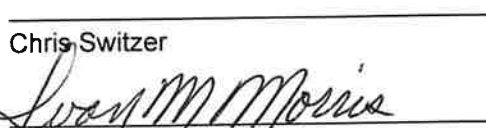
Public Comments. There were none.

Norm Loudermilk stated Homes for Children applied for a Planning Grant through Lilly Endowment for \$150,000. The money would to be used for Capital Outlay. They would like to demolish 2 office buildings behind the group home and rebuild an office building. The grant can be up to \$1 million and he would match 20% from the Non-Reverting Fund. If they can't demo the buildings, they would be using the money to help cover the cost of the requested funds that will be presented to County Council come August.

Chris Switzer stated the Health First Indiana put out the 2025 funding statistics. \$150 million investments lead to \$746 million in cost savings for state residents. The hope is HFI will distribute more funds to the counties.
